Social Distancing Solution

Boogie Mites works with primary schools to provide transition workshops using music and movement activities to promote the development of strong foundations for literacy and maths. To meet the challenges of lockdown, we have compiled an **online course format** for Hampshire County Council schools for provision under Local Authority funded Adult Community Learning contract. The 3-week course follows our **School Ready Literacy Programme to Support Phase One Letters and Sounds**. Courses are being delivered via dedicated private Facebook Groups during May 2020 and feedback is excellent. Head Teachers have jumped to set them up and parent participation is high. Early Years Teachers are also joining the online courses so that they can support families.

AIM

Inform and equip parents with the knowledge confidence and resources for supporting their child's development throughout the summer with music activities that strengthen phonological and special awareness, listening, sequencing skills, confidence and vocabulary.

DELIVERY

The entire course will be managed by Boogie Mites. We will set up a new private Facebook Group for each participating school for parents who have requested to attend the course. Parents will express interest by emailing Boogie Mites to register. They will be sent T&C's for participation in the course and accepted into the Group.

FORMAT

- 7-hour course delivered over 3 weeks
- 3x one-hour live tutorial sessions
- 2x two-hour home learning activity sessions
- Delivered by a trained EY music tutor
- Offered during June – October 2020

CLASSES

- Classes delivered via FB live sessions
- Parent education tips and information posted on the group before and after class
- Year R teachers can meet parents and now children online
- Learners complete weekly feedback via online forms, showing evidence of learning

Ongoing Learning

Digital music packs for each family ensures that they can keep up the regular practise throughout the summer to gain maximum benefits before starting school.

Cost

- 7-hour online course to support School Ready Literacy: £150 + VAT
- Digital music packs (25 songs & parent notes): £4 each (30+ packs) or £6 each (if less than 30) + VAT
